Frequently Asked Questions

Q : When can I register for 2010 School Year?

A : The pre-registration starts at 5/15, and run for 3 weekends: 5/15, 5/22, and 6/5 (no school on 5/29). Registration is open to all currently enrolled students and their siblings on 5/15 and 5/22, and is open to ALL students on 6/5. We do not process registrations after 6/5 and will resume when the school starts.

Q : What's the minimum age to enroll at Chinese School?

A : We follow CVUSD's age requirement; thus student needs to be 4 years old before 12/2 of the school year to enroll in the pre-school class, and 5 years old to enroll in the K class.

Q : Where can I find the registration form?

A : For existing families, the forms with family and student information are printed and ready for you when you register, so just come to the office and bring your checkbook. For new families (not enrolling in the current school year), you may download the blank registration form on the school web site (<http://www.to-cs.org/tocs/>) after 5/22.

Q : What type of language classes do you offer?

A : For all grades we offer both Traditional Chinese and Simplified Chinese classes. For K, 1st, and 2nd grades, we also offer 1 dual language class for each grade where English instructions are used.

Q : May I choose the class/teacher?

A : To ensure even class sizes, we randomly assign students into classes when there are multiple classes of the same type (usually Simplified Chinese). With over 600 students enrolled each year, processing class selection requests would significantly increase our workload.

Q : My kid wants to be in the same class with his/her best friend, may I do that?

A : You may request to be in the same class with one friend. To do this, parents of both students need to register at the same time (so we can put the two forms together).

Q : Who may choose the 3rd period Cultural Classes?

A : 3rd period classes are open to all students grades 1 and above. But some classes have age limits, and there is a minimum enrollment requirement to offer a class.
